First, with sadness we must announce that Robert Wolfe, FNP will be drastically reducing the hours that he is working at Wesley. We wish him luck in his next adventure and are happy that he will still be seeing patients at Wesley during limited weekend and evening hours.

We are happy to introduce our newest Family Nurse Practitioner, Kelly Chavez. Kelly has been with us as a student for over a year and will be starting to see patients full time at our Golden Gate location in July.

Over the past three months, we have implemented a variety of practices to enhance patient safety while continuing to provide the best care for you and your families. We have transitioned the majority of our visits to Telehealth and will continue to operate in this way as we navigate rising case numbers in Arizona. However, there are situations that require an in-person visit, and we are here for you. In order to keep you safe if you need to visit our office, we have implemented the following procedures:

- 1) We are screening everyone with a temperature check and a questionnaire upon entry to the building.
- 2) No additional visitors will be permitted to attend the visit unless a caregiver is required.
- 3) Masks are required by all who enter our facilities.
- 4) Extensive cleaning and sanitation protocols are in place between patients and at the beginning and end of every day.
